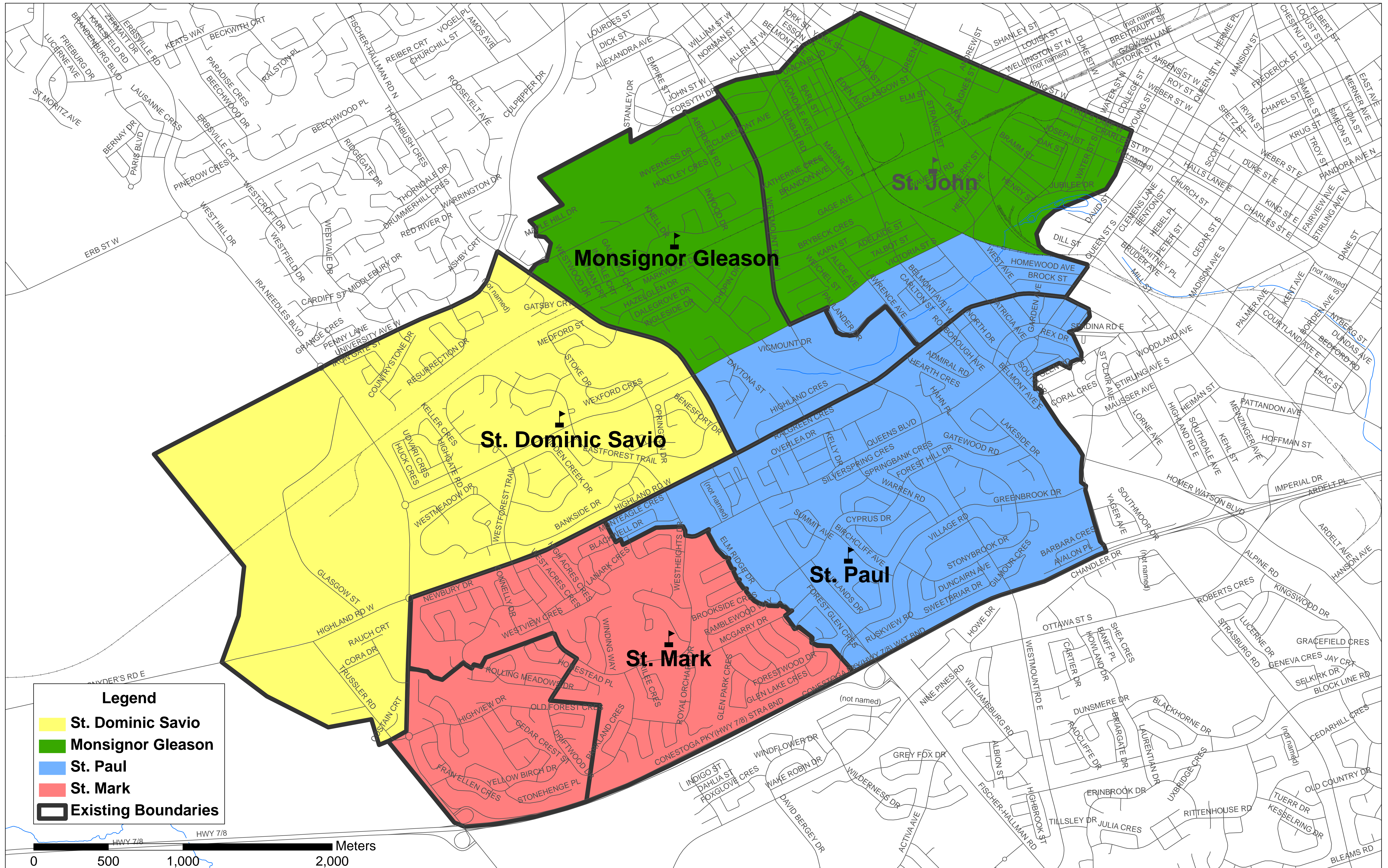


# Option 2b



## DESCRIPTION - Option 2b

### Close St. John

- Move all St. John and Monsignor Gleason students living south of Victoria Street and west of the railway to St. Paul.
- Move all St. John students living north of Victoria Street to Monsignor Gleason.
- St. Paul bussed area move to St. Mark.

## ENROLMENT PROJECTIONS






## ADVANTAGES

	Eliminates the need for major repairs at St. John.
	Overall enrolment and capacity is better balanced across the schools compared to the other options.
	Large site at Monsignor Gleason's has the ability to accommodate portables, an addition and playground facilities.
	Eliminates St. Paul bussed area (i.e. St. Paul only has one boundary).
	Some of the St. Paul bussed area students are able to walk to St. Mark. The majority will continue to be bussed.
	St. Mark is at capacity long term.

## DISADVANTAGES

	The largest number of bussed students (562) compared to the other options.
	Very few students are able to walk (116 of 315 – 37%) to Monsignor Gleason due to the railway – lots of bussing required.
	Affects the largest number of students (370) compared to the other options.
	Eliminates Catholic school presence in the downtown area.
	2-3 portables or a small addition required to Monsignor Gleason.
	1-2 portables required at St. Mark initially.
	Some St. John and Monsignor Gleason students move to a school associated with a different parish.
