

Educational

1. Must be associated with required curriculum expectations for the course and no equivalent Canadian Venue exists for delivering the learning experience.
2. Pre, during, and post activities must be incorporated into the overall assessment of the students performance for reporting purposes.
3. Incorporation of potential Terrorist activity would have to be incorporated as an additional risk factor on the parent permission form.
4. Heightened Terrorist Alerts (Code: Orange or Red) for the targeted excursion state/city would result in a cancellation of the excursion.
5. Travel Alerts designated by the Canadian government for health or safety issues for the targeted excursion state/city would result in a cancellation of the excursion.
6. Heightened Terrorist Alerts or Travel Advisory's announced during the course of an approved excursion would necessitate immediate contact with the school supervisory officer regarding excursion cancellation and safe return procedures.
7. The following list of American Institutions would not be eligible for approval
 - Military related sites
 - U.S. capital government buildings
 - Sites identified by the U.S. government officials as potential targets for Terrorist activity.
8. The cost for staff absence beyond the first two days would be born as an excursion expense and incorporated into the per student cost for the excursion.
9. Monetary losses to staff and/or students including travel deposits resulting from the excursion cancellation prior to or during the excursion is not the responsibility of the school or WCDSB. Reimbursements in whole or part will not be provided. This caution must be placed on the parent permission form.

Extra or Co-curricular

1. The planned excursion would have no equivalent Canadian venue for delivering the activity within the province of Canada.
2. Incorporation of potential Terrorist activity would have to be incorporated as an additional risk factor on the parent permission form.
3. Heightened Terrorist Alerts (Code: Orange or Red) for the targeted excursion state/city would result in a cancellation of the excursion.
4. Travel Alerts designated by the Canadian government for health or safety issues for the targeted excursion state/city would result in a cancellation of the excursion.
5. The following list of American Institutions would not be eligible for approval
 - Military related sites
 - U.S. capital government buildings
 - Sites identified by the U.S. government officials as potential targets for Terrorist activity.
6. Heightened Terrorist Alerts or Travel Advisory's announced during the course of an approved excursion would necessitate immediate contact with the school supervisory officer regarding excursion cancellation and safe return procedures.
7. The cost for staff absence beyond the first two days would be born as an excursion expense and incorporated into the per student cost for the excursion.
8. Monetary losses to staff and/or students including travel deposits resulting from the excursion cancellation prior to or during the excursion is not the responsibility of the school or WCDSB.
