Associate Schools

The following chart represents the Catholic associate elementary schools for each of the Catholic secondary schools. A student's qualification for registration at a particular secondary school is based on the address of the custodial parent's/guardian's principal residence and not exclusively at the elementary school which they attended. Younger

siblings of students affected by the boundary changes in Kitchener-Waterloo, September 2002, are required to attend the Catholic secondary school designated by the custodial parent's/guardian's principal residence. In most cases, this is represented by the associate elementary school groupings below.
