What you need to know about the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD)

A student must successfully complete a minimum of 30 credits (18 compulsory and 12 optional credits), 40 hours of community involvement, and successfully meet the literacy requirement (either the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test - OSSLT, or under certain circumstances the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Course – OSSLC) to obtain an OSSD.
