These people work extremely hard, yet so many of them feel neglected, undervalued, unappreciated, looked down upon, and hardly a part of a catholic community where hope, opportunity, and success for all is the core value. I urge you to consider allocating a greater portion of the budget toward remedying this situation before spending large amounts of money on digital books and other initiatives.
