

Terms of the John Sweeney Memorial Scholarship.

1. The Board of Trustees shall grant annually to a student graduating from one of its secondary schools or continuing education program a scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.
2. The funding for the scholarship shall come from the Board of Trustees' budget line. (The scholarship has now been funded through the Waterloo Catholic Schools Foundation [July 2010]).
3. The first scholarship will be awarded during the Fall 2001 graduation ceremonies for students who graduated during the 2000-2001 school year.
4. In order to receive the scholarship, the recipient must:
 - a) Be a graduating student from one of the Board's secondary schools or continuing education sites; and,
 - b) Be registered in full-time attendance at St. Jerome's University, Waterloo; and,
 - c) Demonstrate qualities such as: perseverance, loyalty, integrity, commitment; and,
 - d) Demonstrate a balanced involvement in their school, church, and civic community.
5. Annually, in September, St. Jerome's University will generate a list of graduates of the Waterloo Catholic District School Board who have registered full-time at St. Jerome's. The students will have graduated from the Waterloo Catholic District School Board during the previous academic year up to and including August 31st of the said previous academic year. [e.g. The list of potential recipients for the first scholarship round will be generated in September 2001 comprising students who graduated from Waterloo Catholic District School Board secondary schools/continuing education sites between September 1st, 2000 and August 31st, 2001].
6. The list will be forwarded to the Director of Education for the Waterloo Catholic District School Board who will share the list with the secondary school principals.
7. The school(s) and representatives from St. Jerome's University and the Waterloo Catholic District School Board will select the recipient based on the criteria outlined in number 4 above.
8. Where, in the opinion of the selection committee, no qualifying candidate comes forth in any given year, the selection committee may allocate the award to previous recipients in order to assist them to complete their studies.
