

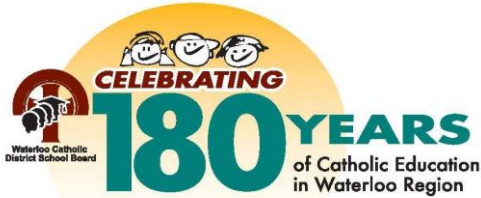

Catholic Board Elects New Trustee

Waterloo Region, ON – The Waterloo Catholic District School Board last night elected Jeanne Gravelle to fill a vacant seat on the Board of Trustees representing the City of Waterloo and the Townships of Wellesley and Woolwich. The vacancy was created by the death of former trustee **Frank Johnson**, who passed away on July 2 after a long and valiant battle with cancer.

Jeanne will serve the remainder of Mr. Johnson's term, which ends in December, 2018. She will be sworn in as a Trustee at the board's monthly meeting on Monday, September 26, 2016.

Eight candidates were interviewed for the position, which was filled via a public interview / vote process under section 221 (1) (a) of the *Education Act*.

The students, staff and trustees of Waterloo Region's Catholic Schools welcome Jeanne to the board.
