Catholic Board Names Distinguished Graduate Award Recipient

Waterloo Region, ON – The Waterloo Catholic District School Board is pleased to announce the naming of *Fr. Toby Collins, C.R.*, as the Board's *Distinguished Graduate Award* recipient. The award will be presented on Thursday, October 4, 2012 during *St. Mary's High School's* annual graduation ceremonies at the Centre in the Square.

A graduate of St. Mary's High School, Fr. Toby completed a degree at Wilfred Laurier University before establishing a landscaping business called *Tiny Toby*. A short time later Fr. Toby decided to enter the priesthood, completing a Masters of Divinity degree and being ordained June 2, 2007 at St. Louis Church in Waterloo.

Father Toby has met with all Chaplains in the Waterloo Catholic District School board and he has been frequently present in the board's secondary schools speaking about religious life.
