Plan Ahead to Attend Access Waterloo Region

Information for persons with disabilities, their families, caregivers, and professionals in Waterloo Region

Waterloo Region, ON – *Access Waterloo Region* is an information fair for people with disabilities and their families, a resource booklet, and a dynamic and regularly updated website called accesswaterlooregion.ca.

On **Tuesday, April 9, 2013** families will be able to speak with agencies about programs and supports and find out about recreation and summer activities.

The accesswaterlooregion.ca website provides information about programs, an updated community calendar, and an activity search. There have been close to 100,000 visits to the site on a monthly basis within the last year. While many programs and services in our community offer support, gaining access to them can be challenging. *Access Waterloo Region* provides an opportunity for people to speak directly with many agencies and to register for recreational programs and summer camps.

For several years the Waterloo Catholic District School Board, the Waterloo Region District School Board and several community partners have teamed up to provide *Access Waterloo Region*. This partnership has been successful in bringing a variety of community programs and services into a central location making it easier to access valuable resources.
