Catholic Board's 2013/14 EQAO Grade 3 and 6 Results Released

Five year trend mirrors provincial trend with gains
in reading / writing; declines in math

Waterloo Region, ON – The Waterloo Catholic District School Board today released its 2013-14 *Education Quality and Accountability Office (EQAO)* assessment results for Grades three and six. Results for Grade nine math and the Grade 10 Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test will be released on Wednesday, September 24, 2014 as per provincial government regulations.

QuickFacts

- ✓ Grade three five year trend mirrors the provincial trend with overall gains of +6% in reading, +9% in writing and a decline of -7% in math.
- ✓ Grade six five year trend mirrors the provincial trend with overall gains of +7% in reading, +8% in writing and a decline of -5% in math.
- ✓ This year's WCDSB results for Grade three vs. last year's results show a gain of +3% in writing and no change in reading and math.
- ✓ This year's WCDSB results for Grade six vs. last year's results show a gain of +2% in reading, a gain of +1% in writing and a decline of -1% in math (Note: the provincial decline in Grade 6 math was -3%).
