WCDSB “Wheeling for Healing” Team Hits the Road to Conquer Cancer!

WCDSB staff raises \$52,816.50!

Waterloo Region, ON – WCDSB web developer **Darcy Davis**, resource library technician **Peggie Nicolson** and specialist high skills major / technology consultant **Rob Holowack** led a team of 17 riders who raised almost \$53,000 in the Ride To Conquer Cancer this past weekend.

The team rode in support of WCDSB community members fighting cancer. Money raised will benefit the **Campbell Family Institute** at the **Princess Margaret Hospital** -- one of the top five cancer research centres in the world.

Day # 1 of the ride involved cycling from Toronto to Hamilton. **Day #2** started in Hamilton and ended in Niagara Falls. Riders on both days chose to participate in either a 100 mile route or a 100 kilometre route.

Team members organized fund raisers at their schools and work sites significantly increasing last year’s total of \$11,000 raised for this great cause.
