3. My password belongs only to me. I will not share my password. I will not try to learn the passwords of others.
4. I will tell a teacher or supervisor what I am doing while on the Internet when asked.
5. If, by mistake, I go to a scary or bad site, I will tell my teacher right away.
6. If I do not follow the rules, I will not be able to go on the Internet.

In an effort to support our student's safety and mental well-being, and in the context of prioritizing safe schools, we are committed to maintaining a level of oversight within our schools' online communities. The Student Aware program monitors online traffic through accounts linked to Waterloo Catholic District School Board (WCDSB) network, filtering high risk searches into the following categories: suicide, cyber bullying, malware, violence, exploitation, abuse or other dangerous online activity. The Student Aware Coordinator follows up with Administrators to support student and school safety.
