- Ongoing discussions about school and board communication tools (email, apps, etc.)
- Engaged in conversations around traffic, parking, and winter trail maintenance
- Supported city planning efforts for future water drainage improvements

We're proud to report that this year's fundraising efforts were a great success, thanks to your generosity and community spirit. Together, we raised funds through the following initiatives:

- **Dance-a-thon**: Raised: \$ 4,946.00
- **Read-a-thon & Family Fun Night**: Raised: \$4,085
- **Maple Syrup Fundraiser (with the Knights of Columbus)**: Raised: \$293.00

These funds helped cover remaining playground costs and supported many of the events and initiatives listed above.
