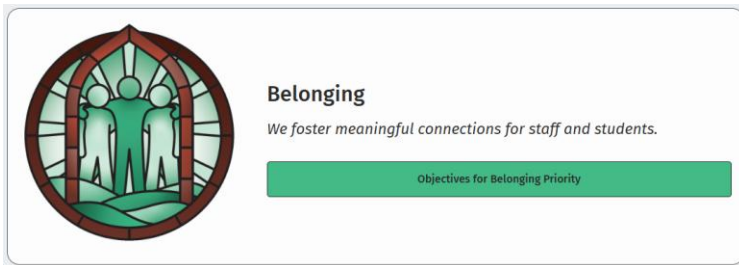
Objectives for Serving Priority
