Principal Update	Michael	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> End of year procedures taking place (staffing, class lists, enrollment, etc.) Michael confirmed that the coloured poles in the kindie yard will be removed this summer Quote for triple hoop, one basketball net along grass or replacing backboard on existing pole by kindie fence, quoted Michael received quotes from the two companies for all the schoolyard equipment we wanted to order and prices are as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Gagaball pit in the 25'x25' size: \$4915 including installation Second quote: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Basketball net for primary area: \$2229 *Replacing backboard for existing post: \$1700 Triple hoop game: \$1449 Freight: \$735 Installation of these three items: \$1720 Total \$8851.29 (includes an extra backboard and net for the existing pole. Without that, the installation and equipment subtotal)

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We discussed the location of these items at length and discussed whether to keep the old basketball net pole or not. It eventually was decided that the money would be best used by getting the gagaball pit, the new basketball net placed along the grass area, and getting two triple hoop games rather than replacing the old basketball net/backboard. The installation fee and freight may slightly change. Michael will get a new official quote.

Tickets used by station: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 259 chips; 466 pop; 118 juice; 121 water - Baked goods 439; Candy 722 – maybe look at reviewing ticket prizes - mini cupcakes shouldn't be the same as bigger baked items - Games 548 (cornhole, Nintendo switch, lucky ducky - Photobooth 70 tickets Pizza made total \$250 Silent Auction made \$2395 total (\$2141 last year) Sports tickets and principal for a day did the best for auction items 15 (19?) sponsor tickets \$5944.85 total raised, last year \$5079 so a good improvement Feedback: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sponsor family tickets: need to make sure these families end up on the pizza list and admission list so they aren't having to reveal that they were a sponsored family. - We tend to get more sponsored tickets than we have families using them, so it was suggested that we pool the money raised from that and can make it a full package to sponsor a family, including pizza and games/candy tickets as well. - Review ticket "prices" for the baked goods rather than a broad 2 tickets for baking and 1 ticket for candy. Mini cupcakes shouldn't have the same value as bigger items. Michael brought up that while he does enjoy the valentine's Dance, Dance-a-thon events tend to bring in more fundraising dollars and are much easier to put on. We discussed this at length as well, and decided next year, we could try a Halloween Dance-a-thon since they have the dance that day anyway.
