	• Mable's Labels- Currently have \$13.33 in profit not yet deposited to the school • Shrove Tuesday- CSAC spent \$207.06 on supplies for pancakes • Candy Grams- CSAC spent \$186.54 on lollipops and raised \$575 in sales for a total profit of \$388.41 • Papa Johns- There were 16 orders for the Monsignor Haller fundraiser totaling roughly \$32 in profit- Amount will be confirmed by Gary • Class Supplies- Confirmed \$100 went to each class for supplies, totalling \$1700 from CSAC. Some teachers have not used the funds yet, Gary will look into who still needs to spend theirs.

Notes:	• Mabel's Labels- Need to push out more emails to parents to increase profits. Magda will get some Mabels Labels brochures to add to the Kindie Night bags on May 27th • Candy Grams- Promotion was very successful, we sold more lollipops than expected. Magda purchased the lollipops and packaged them together, students cut out the paper tags. Paper tags will be put in the CSAC folder for use next year. • Papa Johns Pizza- Papa Johns offered a special promotion for Monsignor Haller with a portion of the proceeds going to the school. The promotion only got 16 orders and made minimal profit. Need to consider if this is something worth doing next year. • Dance-A-Thon- Taking place March 13th. Baskets are complete and on display in the library. Donations for basket items were very successful. ○ Pledges/glow stick sales are coming in on School Cash online. So far 400 glow sticks have been sold, pledge sales are currently lower than expected ○ Glow Sticks sales: 2 for \$1 ○ Pledges: 1 Ticket for \$3, 2 Tickets for \$5, and 5 Tickets for \$10 ○ Need paper bags for tickets- magda will supply ○ Set up tables with baskets the day before the event- Kelli, Magda, Sasha, and Rebecca will help. ○ Glow sticks and pledge tickets need to be organized by class and in teachers' mail boxes by the end of day Thursday. Magda and Rebecca

	will organize pledge tickets on Thursday morning (Kelli and Sasha will also help). Kelli will organize glow sticks. ○ Magda and Rebecca need to submit receipts for supplies ● MacMillan's- Discussed running a MacMillan's fundraiser and agreed it was worth looking into. Magda will reach out to the company to see when/if a promo can be started.

Notes:	● Movie Night- Discussed the possibility of an end of year movie night for families. Decided to look at other ideas as we were not sure if this would be feasible due to logistical issues: ○ Movie has to be in the gym due to weather concerns and timing-is the gym big enough? Will it be too hot? ○ Movie would need to be on Learn 360 to avoid royalties ● Kindie Night-Want to use this as an opportunity to promote parent council. Need to decide if we want to add a flyer to the Kindie Night bags or have a booth. We are leaning towards doing both. Magda is looking into developing a flyer and next meeting we will discuss a booth and what that would look like. ● Pumpkin Patch-Discussed how to best incorporate this fundraiser into the next school year. ○ Sasha will look into local pumpkin farms and what promos they run for next fall ○ Gary suggested the idea of having a skid of pumpkins delivered to the school for parents to order and pick up ○ Do we run a pumpkin carving competition for the classrooms with a grand prize supplied by CSAC, maybe a pizza party? ● Multicultural Night- teachers are still planning a multicultural night for students with a tentative date of June 9th or 10th. Once confirmed we can discuss if we can work a fundraiser into this event, possibly pop and chip sales or Papa Johns.

Notes:	Shrove Tuesday- Shrove Tuesday was a success, it ran very smoothly and the kids really enjoyed it. CSAC supplied pancake mix, syrup, plates, forks and large ziploc bags. The teachers supplied griddles, bowls, spatulas and ladles. Teachers and their friends/family volunteered to cook pancakes in the gym for Kindie to grade 8 classes. Extra syrup needed to be purchased on the day, the cost was covered by Jessie. Considering running the event the same way in the future, with CSAC purchasing more syrup next year. Mt. Mary- The Mt.
