Notes:	• Mable's Labels-Made a total of \$31.25 this year • Dance-A-Thon- Glow sticks raised a total of \$215.02 and pledges raised \$1514 for a grand total of \$1729.02 in profits • Current account balance is \$13,392,17- this does not include the \$1800 spent for each class to purchase \$100 in supplies. Only 4 of 18 teachers have currently used this money, we need to confirm at the end of the year what was actually spent so we can deduct from the account total. • We have a playground budget that needs to be spent, we will discuss in September how to best allocate this. • Sasha, Magda and Kelli voted to allocate funds to purchase book carts for grades 1-3. Cost is roughly \$1800 for three carts and \$3000 in books to fill all three carts, totaling \$4800. Gary will confirm the final cost and what will be covered by CSAC.

We decided it was successful and we will run it the same way next year but would like to make sure every child gets one free pledge ticket. • Family Night- Want to find a way to have a family event of some sort at the end of next year. Will discuss ideas at the start of the new school year. • Pumpkin Patch-Sasha has reached out to 3 local pumpkin patches regarding running a fundraiser in Sept/Oct. She has not heard back from them yet about what the fundraising possibilities are but will continue to look into it over the summer. We would need to have the fundraiser in place by Oct 15th so families could have their pumpkins for Halloween. • Terra Cotta Cookies- We decided to run a Terra Cotta fundraiser for Christmas next school year. Magda will send out an e-mail to Terra Cotta in September to book a December fundraiser with a pick up date for mid December, if possible. • Meet the Teacher Night (Sept 17)- Decided to set up a pizza fundraiser with Papa Johns for Meet the Teacher Night so families could purchase pizza to take

	home or possibly eat on location. Gary will look into setting this up and CSAC will help where needed.
